Dear Lake Burton Civic Assoc. Member,

A unique opportunity to “do well by doing good,” (a sentiment attributed to Ben Franklin) exists in the Georgia Qualified Education Expense Credit which is offered by the Georgia Department of Revenue. As long time LBCA members we take pride in the community and want you to know of a unique way to support one of our local institutions at NO COST TO YOU.

Simply put, if you file a joint Georgia tax return, you can make a donation of up to \$2,500 to the private secondary school of your choice and treat the entire amount as a Georgia tax credit. If you owe as much as \$2,500 in Georgia Income tax in 2010, the entire amount of your contribution wipes out your tax obligation – up to \$2,500. This is the second and possibly final year of this program.

We have both elected to take advantage of this unique opportunity and have designated

**Rabun Gap-Nacoochee School**

as the recipient of our contributions this year. We encourage you to do the same or, if you are so inclined, make the donation to another school, but don't let this opportunity pass you by.

We suggest that you first call your tax adviser to clarify any questions you may have and then call Katrina Graham at Rabun Gap-Nacoochee School to start the process.
